Choir - Wednesdays 2:50-3:50 pm

Instrumental Music - Wednesdays 4:00-5:00 pm

The first day of class is Wednesday, August 24, 2016. Classes are held weekly. Students participating in either of the programs are expected to arrive to and depart from the Sunrise Elementary School Multipurpose Room at the times outlined above. Supervision will not be provided before or after the scheduled class times. If transportation becomes an issue, we will make every effort to assist you, but serious issues may require us to drop your student from the program.

Classes will be held at its regularly scheduled time on all days that school is held, including track change days. You will be notified of any changes to the class schedule. We reserve the right to dismiss any student from either of the programs. It is important to remember that any student missing more than 2 classes (except when off track) may be dismissed from the program if they have missed or forgotten too much of the curriculum.

Academic/Behavior Guidelines

Your student is required to remain in good standing in his/her classes while participating in this program. If necessary, your student may be permanently dismissed due to any hazardous behavior while participating in either program. If necessary, you may be contacted to come pick up your student prior to the end of class. Your student must be picked up or he/she may not be allowed to return to class. If you are contacted to pick up your student due to behavioral reasons, he/she will be counted absent for that day.

We do not provide homework assistance. If you're interested in having homework assistance or additional chaperoning on class days, please contact your school's Champions Afterschool Program.
